## Upcoming Events:

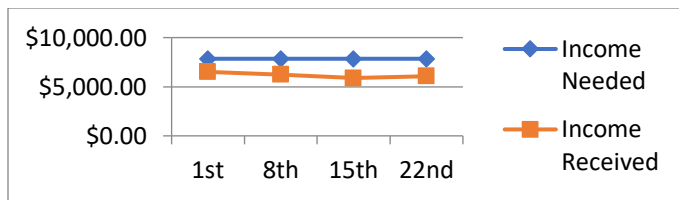
