ADVENT MESSY SUNDAY :

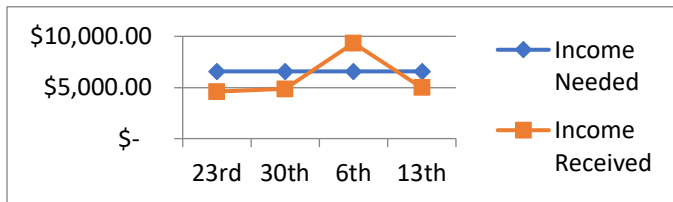
